



Rocky Point Pinot Noir 2012



Bright fruit aromatics, rich and silky smooth. The Rocky Point wines are a great introduction to Central Otago and the Prophet's Rock range.

VINEYARD:

The grapes were sourced from the two Prophet's Rock estate vineyards in the Bendigo sub-region of Central Otago. Extensive canopy and crop management was carried out during the growing season to ensure the grapes attained full physiological ripeness with good concentration and flavour.

WINE:

"This is really good. The fragrant bouquet shows dark cherry, plum, game and floral with a hint of cedar complexity. It's succulent and concentrated on the palate with purity and intensity, leading to a superbly long velvety finish. The wine combines fruit richness with subtle savoury notes, making it immensely appealing."

WINEMAKING:

The grapes were handpicked and with fermentation by indigenous 'wild' yeast. The wine was hand-plunged during fermentation and then aged in French oak barrels from a variety of Burgundy cooperages and forests.
