Vineyard

The grapes were sourced from an elevated site in the Pisa sub region of Central Otago. The site has warm free draining soils featuring schist and glacial outwash over sandy gravels.

Extensive canopy and crop management was carried out during the growing season to ensure the grapes attained full physiological ripeness with great concentration, aromatics and flavour.

Vintage Notes

After a cool Spring the 2013 season transitioned into a more stable warm summer with a long dry Autumn. This allowed extended ripening and full aromatic expression with great concentration. Grapes were picked mid-April.

Winemaking

The grapes for this wine were handpicked and field sorted, once at the winery the fruit was whole-bunch pressed to retain maximum aromatics and freshness.

The wine was fermented using only indigenous 'wild' yeast in multiple small lots. Once fermentation was completed the wine was matured on its yeast lees prior to bottling on the 16th of May 2014. Bottled under Diam cork which are certified taint-free.
