



# Rocky Point Pinot Noir Rosé 2016

## Vineyard

*The Pinot Noir grapes for this Rosé were sourced from two blocks in our Rocky Point estate vineyard in the Bendigo sub-region of Central Otago. This spectacular steep site on schist rock soil rises from Lake Dunstan at 220m to over 350m elevation. These two blocks of Clone UDC5 or 'Pommard' were specifically selected, farmed and harvested for our Rosé. Extensive canopy and crop management was carried out during the growing season to ensure the grapes attained full physiological ripeness with good acidity, concentration and flavour.*

## Winemaking

*The grapes were handpicked and destemmed into tank where they picked up colour and flavour before gentle pressing. The wine was then fermented using only indigenous 'wild' yeast in multiple small lots. Once fermentation was completed the wine was matured on its yeast lees prior to bottling on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2016.*

## The Wine

*Pale red in colour this Rosé displays light red berries, rose, mandarin and spice on the nose. On the palate the generous texture opens up into wild strawberries and citrus with crisp acidity and a long mineral finish. A very adaptable dry food wine and perfect summer drinking.*
