

# Prophet's Rock, Home Vineyard, Pinot Noir 2014, Central Otago, New Zealand



Complex aromatics and a beautifully balanced palate made this wine an easy Gold medal winner. 'A top nose,' said team leader Carlos Ferreira, describing 'notes of leather, tobacco and dried red and black fruits, with hints of vanilla'. 'The palate is also very well made with lots of fruit, while the acidity and balance of the finish is excellent... Pinot Noir for any white meat,' he concluded.
